1 Unpack HDVMixer

HDV-WSN4SDI Video Core computer with mouse, keyboard and power chord.

HDVMixer FULL-Size Package additionally includes:

4 x robotic PTZ cameras

1 x SmartCAM-876, 6 channel audio & GPI interface with Breakout Cables.

1 Audio Cable from Audio Card to Console (if ordered with audio card).

2 Register your Software

- + In the software splash screen, when HDVMixer opens;
- + On the security USB Dongle (installed inside the Video Core computer).

Team Viewer software has been preloaded in your Video Core computer. In order to access your Video Core computer and provide you with remote support, our team will ask for your Software License ID. Remote access will allow us to train your staff more efficiently and in less time. We also provide periodical technical checkups to those customers under the 'remote health monitoring support plan'. 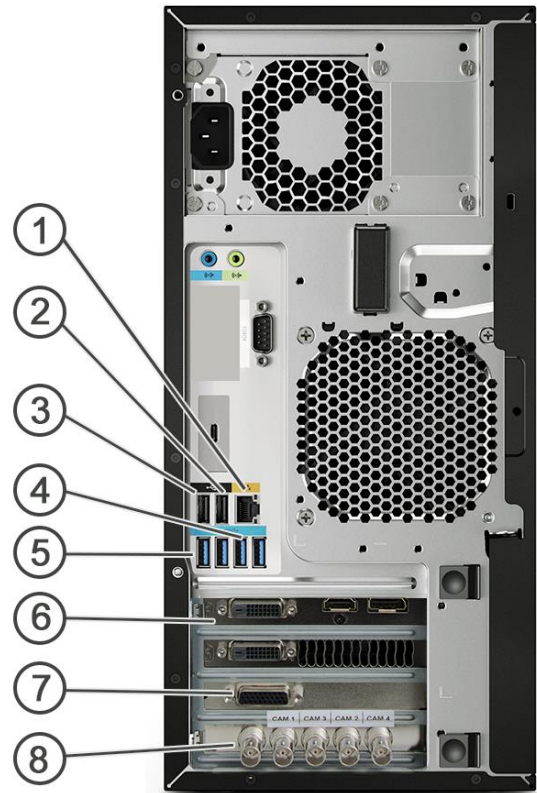

5 Quick Setup Guide

HDVMixer FULL Size Package:

- 1 Connect computer to LAN/Internet
- 2, 3 Connect keyboard and mouse to USB or PS 2
- 4 Additional USB ports. Leave empty.
- 5 Connect SmartCAM-876 to this USB port.
- 6 Nvidia Graphics Card:
Connect your Control Room Monitors and Studio Monitor.
Connectors may vary according to model. Check the back of the Video Core computer for specific instructions.
- 7 Connect Audio Cable with multiple Audio inputs and outputs.
- 8 BlackMagic Card:
Connect Cameras to the card's SDI inputs as labeled.

After all connections are set up, plug in your Video Core, turn it on and double-click on 'Start HDVMixer' icon in Windows Desktop.
